## Central South Dakota Kids Fishing Weekend at Lake Sharpe -- SUCCESS!

The second annual Kid's Fishing Weekend was held in Pierre June 7-9 at Down's Marina in Pierre and was again a huge success!! This event was sponsored and put on by many local individuals, businesses, GF&P, and the Pierre chapter of SDWU. Doug Iverson and Ken Steiner of Pierre have spearheaded this event from inception to success and much of the organizational work was done by the staff at Capital Motors with assistance from SD GF&P. The goal of this event was simple -- get kids out on the water. The format for this event was equally as simple: pair less experienced anglers with others that can show them how and where to fish. On Friday evening every youth participant was given a rod and reel, a water bottle, stickers and other items and was introduced to his or her "guide" for the next day. On Saturday, local anglers took 2-4 kids per boat out on the water for 3 hours of fishing on Lake Sharpe, either in the morning or the afternoon. In addition to boaters, at least 1 additional adult volunteer went out in each boat to help bait hooks, net fish, and otherwise ensure that the kids had a great time.



Over 190 kids participated in this year's event which was a large increase over the 2012 inaugural event that brought out 130 kids. Many fish were caught, prizes given away and hot dogs and brats eaten on Saturday. It was simply amazing to see all of the kids running around with big smiles on their faces, telling their parents or friends about all of the fish they had caught.

A special thanks to all of the SDWU members in the Pierre area who helped make this event possible. In addition to local anglers, we had people drive in from all over the state to take kids out fishing. I cannot thank them enough for taking time away to help out.


